



TEMPLAR LITE

Templar Lite is an AS2 Compliant EDI Transmission solution which allows you to quickly and easily exchange files with your selected trading partner.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start the Templar Lite configuration tool from Program Files/Templar/Templar Lite Configuration. This will display the following screen:

2. Enter your AS2 ID and local e-mail address and select your local certificate. This needs to be in a p12 or pfx file
3. Enter your partner's AS2 ID and e-mail address and select their certificate. This needs to be a cer file.
4. Enter the URL that your partner uses to receive AS2 Data
5. If you wish to receive asynchronous MDNs, enter your full internet host name (such as templar.mycompany.com). If you want to receive files, your machine must be publicly

accessible over the internet. This may require configuration of your router and firewall, which is outside the scope of this document.

6. If you wish to change the incoming AS2 Port or incoming MDN port (possibly due to conflicts with other software on your computer) you can change them on this screen. The URL your partner needs to send you files will then be <http://youreexternalhostname:AS2Port> and the URL for receiving MDNs will be <http://youreexternalhostname:MDNPort> (you generally won't need to know this last one as the URL is automatically passed to your trading partner as part of the file transmission). For example, if your public internet name is `templar.mycompany.com` and the value you entered for the Incoming AS2 Port is 10080, then the full URL your partner needs to send you files is <http://templar.mycompany.com:10080>. Please note that Templar Lite does not support https transfers but all data is encrypted and therefore your confidential information is secure.
7. Certain changes will require you to restart the Templar Lite service (you will be informed if this is the case). To do this, go to Control Panel, Administrative, Services. Find Templar Lite in the list of services, right click and select Restart. You must have administrative privileges on the computer to do this. Alternatively, simply restart the computer.
8. When you have finished making changes to your configuration, click OK. To abandon all changes, click Cancel.
9. To send a file(s) to a trading partner, simply copy it to the following directory:
C:\AS2Data\toAS2Remote.
10. Incoming files from your partner will appear in the Inbox folder under c:\AS2Data
11. Incoming MDN files will appear under C:\AS2Data\MDN in subfolders according to the date of receipt.
